It will start at the intersection of Route 42 and South Main Street, and it will continue past the firehouse.

Tickets cost \$20 each and are on sale at the firehouse, our website, from Beacon Hose members, and at Gabe's Automotive and the River's Edge Pub and Grille. The drawing will be held Oct. 17 at 4 p.m.; winners need not be present. There are only 2,500 tickets, so don't wait!

We know this year's carnival will be different, but we're excited to see everyone again! We'll be serving up our fried dough, lobster bombs and rolls, and all your other favorites — and we'll be throwing in a few fall-themed goodies in the food tents and by the beer truck, too.
